  - Evaluate shipment schedules/allocations to control costs and improve margin across breeding stock and market business units
  - Evaluate inventory management processes of owned farms and contract multiplication systems to drive down costs of holding excessive inventory
- Administration
  - Data management and order entry
  - Invoice reconciliation and exception reporting
  - o Customer service-related activities as needed
- Communication to relevant parties across the business to ensure safe, timely, humane and biosecure movement of animals
- Ad Hoc projects and business development objectives
- Solves problems in straightforward situations; analyzes possible solutions using technical/functional experience and judgment and precedents
