Core Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and execution of monitoring programs for data collection integrity and genetic gain with a focus on employee safety and herd biosecurity while maintaining compliance to labor regulation; Monitor accuracy evaluations and intervene, when necessary, with appropriate training for staff
- Ensure successful implementation of Standard Operating Procedures in order to produce repeatable and measurable results throughout all areas of responsibility
- Understand and demonstrate on testing and off testing processes as well as leg scoring and probing processes in accordance to protocols
- Ensure test targets are met, and when unable to do so, ensure timely communication with relevant parties occurs
- Monitor implementation of bio-security program and intervene, when necessary, with appropriate training for staff
- Develop and execute training tools and adapt evolving technologies into daily management
- Measure and report progress to supply chain management, product development team, and export teams while maintaining a highly functional relationship; Present recommendations, results and experience gained to broader audiences both within production teams, within the company, and in public forums
- Provide management or oversight of collaborative technical projects as needed
- Collaborate to create personnel development plans for self and/or others and cascade those through the operational unit as needed
