


Truck Wash Biosecurity




1 No recycled water used to wash trucks.

3 Ensure trucks are cleaned, disinfected, and dry before use. Visually inspect the trailers before use.



Clean and disinfect inside of cab between loads.

CRITICAL FAIL POINTS



Lack of defined traffic pattern through wash and clean/dirty areas in the yard. Examples include:

- Clean trailer parked next to a dirty trailer in wash bay.
- Inadequate bay decontamination between washes.
- Personnel moving between clean and dirty equipment without proper biosecurity protocols.
- Non-biosecure traffic pattern through wash.



Use of recycled water.

Lack of adherence to defined biosecure protocol and/ or SOP to wash, disinfect, and dry equipment.



Use of disinfectants not agreed with your vet (for final wash).
